From the beginning Tahoe Mountain Resorts Foundation has invested in civic and charitable causes to improve the Truckee-North Tahoe quality of life. As part of this local involvement, TMR Foundation has contributed to numerous community organizations, including: Tahoe Forest Hospital and Hospice, Workforce Housing Association of Truckee Tahoe, Tahoe Women's Services, Truckee Little League, Girl Scouts, Lake Tahoe Musical Festival, Boy's and Girl's Club of North Lake Tahoe and the North Tahoe Art Center and Project MANA to name a few.

ARTS FOR THE SCHOOLS – Arts for the Schools (AFtS) is responsible for bringing high-caliber professional artists to local Truckee and North Lake Tahoe schools for more than two decades. Tahoe Mountain Resorts Foundation has supported AFtS through donations to the Terry Yagura Endowment Fund helping to continue to bring international artists to our schools and community. This enriches the cultural and interactive life of our whole community by providing access, awareness, education and opportunity for cultural and artistic expression.

TRUCKEE DONNER LAND TRUST – The Truckee Donner Land Trust works to preserve and protect important historic, recreational and scenic open spaces in the greater Truckee region. Tahoe Mountain Resorts Foundation and the TMR Environmental Fund provide a significant source of funds that allows the TDLT to work with landowners, federal, state and local governments, and the public-at-large, to create win-win situations for private and public interests. The support of the TMR foundation and Environmental Fund allows the TDLT to carry out its mission by negotiating easements, land exchanges and land acquisitions. So far TDLT has protected over 11,000 acres. In the coming years, TDLT is planning to protect over 35,000 acres with a value in excess of \$110 million.

ARC – Adventure Risk & Challenge provides critical tools for life growth to at risk high school students through developmental activities and experiences with a goal toward academic achievement, personal development and quality of life. Tahoe Mountain Resorts Foundation has been a major contributor since ARC's inception and continues to support ARC's goal to foster intellectual, social and ethical development by preparing students to become engaged and constructive members of a diverse, dynamic and global society.

TRUCKEE HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS – Tahoe Mountain Resorts Foundation is committed to supporting the scholastic efforts of graduating high school seniors from Truckee High School. Each year TMR Foundation awards six scholarships totaling \$37,000. From the large number of students who apply, the TMRF scholarship committee reviews all applicants in depth and selects 12 finalists for interviews with the committee. Making the final selections is difficult as all of the applicants are usually exceptional. The criteria used to select the candidates include financial need, academic performance, extra-curricular activities and an essay provided by the student. The final decision on who are awarded the scholarships is the result of individual interviews with the selection committee.
